On the afternoon of 29 June, IEEP, IDDRI and top speakers of the European institutions and the Trio Presidency (France, the Czech Republic and Sweden) will discuss the main results of the second edition of the European Green Deal Barometer (first edition [here](#)) and reflect on what is needed to advance the Green Deal implementation. The Barometer results are based on the views of 300+ of sustainability experts collected through a Europe-wide survey that was conducted by IEEP between April and May 2022.

The second day, 30 June, will look at key thematic areas – ranging from climate and energy to sustainable food systems – and refine policy recommendations targeted at the Trio Presidency, the European Parliament and the European Commission.




