

# Our scoreboard in 2019



## Scoreboard 2024

Developed jointly with the European Environmental Bureau, BirdLife, Transport & Environment and WWF European Policy Office.

3 pillars: 1) Climate-neutral and socially-just transition 2) Nature positive 3) Zero pollution and circular economy

#### Criteria for the selection of 30 policy files:

- Importance of the file for the European Green Deal
- Availability of data
- Specific expertise within the five organisations

#### Criteria for the selection of 124 <u>votes</u>:

- Ambition ahead of trilogue negotiations
- Representation of civil society priorities
- Relevance in determining the Parliament's position on a file











## **EU Political Groups Results: Climate & just transition**

## A mixed picture on climate ambition

- There were MEPs who made serious efforts to secure a socially-just transition to climate neutrality, from the left to the centre-right.
- However, only a minority in the Parliament (the Greens/EFA) and The Left) voted to unlock the benefits of this transition for all of society.
- To keep the 1.5°C target of the Paris Agreement attainable, the next European Parliament needs to support an acceleration of climate action, with deep and rapid emission cuts this decade.

## **Overall conclusions**


- Major gaps exist between citizens' priorities and the voting records of groups and national parties.

- ...and then Protectors in all political groups need to step up in the next mandate.










